Assemble an emergency supplies kit with 72 hours' worth of food and water. In case of an emergency event, you may be stuck at home without electricity for 3 days or more. It's imperative that you're prepared. Also create an emergency communication plan. This plan ensures that everyone in your family knows how to stay in touch.
