Information for New Freshman and Their Family

Welcome to the Winston-Salem State University Class of 2020! Before you know it, August will be here and along with August comes:

- New Freshman Move-In Day
- New Freshman Orientation (RAMDITION)
- First day of classes for all students

There are several enrollment steps you need to complete prior to August. However, we encourage you to complete these steps as soon as possible. *We already have confirmation of intent to enroll for 77% of the freshman class capacity.* Steps like on-campus housing assignments and registration for Rams at Home are secured on a first-come, first-serve basis.

CHECKLIST

- Confirm your intent to enroll at WSSU
- Know your WSSU email address and logon to your email account
- Apply for on-campus housing and pay the \$135 housing application fee
- Register for a Rams at Home Session
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Complete FAFSA Verification, if selected
- Accept any loans awarded that you will need to pay your student bill
- Complete Loan Entrance Counseling and Master Promissory Note, if loans are accepted
- Apply for a Parent-Plus Loan if you need additional funds to pay your student bill
- Submit information for external scholarships you will use to pay your student bill
- Submit an official, final high-school transcript
- Submit your Immunization and Health History forms
- *Enroll or Waive mandatory student health insurance
- Pay the \$165 New Freshman Orientation (RAMDITION) fee
- *Complete ALCOHOLEDU and HAVEN online courses and assessment
- Pay your student bill

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

Check your student email frequently for updates from WSSU

Your official, final high school transcript must be on file before your financial aid award can be used to pay your student bill

You will not be allowed to move into your residence hall until Student Health Services has confirmed that you meet the State of North Carolina Immunization Requirements
