Degree Works *RAMPath* provides a degree evaluation that is personalized for each undergraduate student. Your Degree Works *RAMPath* evaluation is a guide to help you create your educational plan and allows you to keep track of all the degree requirements for graduation. On your degree evaluation, you will see every requirement for your major(s) and minor(s) that you must complete in order to graduate from WSSU. In addition, you will see which requirements you have already satisfied, denoted by a green check; those requirements that are in progress, denoted by a blue ~; and any requirements that are still outstanding, denoted by an empty red check-box. Students should use their Degree Works *RAMPath* degree evaluation every semester when selecting courses for the upcoming term, as well as when making a long-term, semesterby-semester graduation plan.

Students can access their individualized Degree Works *RAMPath* evaluation by following these steps:

- 1. Open the Google Chrome web browser
- 2. Go to MyWSSU (https://my.wssu.edu) and click on the RAMPath icon to access
- 3. Enter your RAM ID and Password to log in
- 4. Click **Sign In** this will automatically generate your Degree Evaluation Worksheet. Below you will find a summary of each block and the important information each section contains.

Student View Block: This section will provide an overall summary of your personal academic information including your classification, academic advisor, overall GPA, catalog year, level, degree, major(s), credits earned, credits in progress - if applicable, minor(s), concentration(s), transfer credits, academic standing, graduation status, and any holds that may prevent future course registration or release of academic records.
