

**WINSTON-SALEM STATE UNIVERSITY**  
**INFORMATION FOR CONTRACTING WITH STUDENTS**  
**AS INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS**

As a Winston-Salem State University student contracting with the University as an independent contractor, you should generally be aware of the following:

- Your contract with the University is not necessarily contingent upon your status as a student at this University.
- If you breach your contract with the University, you may be liable to the University for money damages.
- You may or may not owe Federal and/or State taxes on the money you earn from the University under this contract.
- If the University pays you more than six hundred dollars (\$600.00) during the calendar year, you will be sent an IRS form 1099-Misc. at the end of the calendar year.
- Depending on the amount of money you earn, your financial aid award for the next school year may be different than it was for this year.
- If you are unsure what any of the terms of the contract mean, you may get the advice of an outside attorney. The University and its employees cannot provide you with advice regarding the terms of this contract.
