

Distance Learning Students should only register for class sections with the following suffixes; -WC, -WD, -WE, etc.


Note: -EW is NOT the same as -WE!

You can also determine if there are available seats in the class. Click on "*Art 1301-WC*" and the page below will open. There are 7 seats available for this course so when Registration opens you can register for *Art 1301-WC*.



If there are zero seats available in a –WC section, check to see if there is a –WD or –WE section that has available seats. If there are no seats in a Distance Learning section then it is very possible that during Drop/Add week a seat may become available so continue to check the seat availability. IF there are no seats available and you need the course then you can email the instructor and ask to be manually added to the class.

- Another option you have is to go back to the Curriculum Guide of courses and find a different course that satisfies the Area of Knowledge for Fine Arts. (Finding the list of courses to meet a specific Area of Knowledge was covered in a previous presentation.)
- For example, Music 1301 –WC will meet the Area of Knowledge for Fine Arts.
