For example, if a total of 59 credits have been earned from blocks 1-3, an additional 1 credit hour in general education is required. If 58 credits have been earned from blocks 1-3, an additional 2 credit hours in general education are required. Electives must be selected from the Transfer Course List in the Comprehensive Articulation Agreement.*
