3	December 10, 2021	FINANCIAL CLEARANCE The Graduation Fee of \$50.00 is automatically charged to your student account bythe Office of the Registrar. Please clear with Student Accounts, 200 Thompson Center by Friday, December 10, 2021, to make sure you have nooutstanding charges to your student account. Students can start paying their fee immediately. Also check with Campus Police and the Library to clear any outstanding fines or debts that have been posted to your student account.
