#### **Innovations in Teaching:**

Using a mini simulation activity in the classroom as a teaching strategy: The students were assigned into groups. There were 4 groups with 4 students per group. Each group was given an opportunity to select a scenario by pulling an index card out of an envelope which included information describing the nurse administrators' span of authority. The groups with the scenarios descriptions consisted of the following: authority often extends beyond nursing; authority has the accountability for ensuring safe and cost-effective nursing practice across the organization and integrated delivery system; authority includes handling the daily operations of multiple units or departments; and authority most often directs a single defined area. The students were given 45 minutes for group collaboration. After completing the collaborative assignment each group delivered a 30-minute presentation discussing and analyzing the various titles the DNP leaders may obtain based on the selected span of authority.

Physical activity with gaming as a teaching strategy to increase student engagement: The activities were incorporated into an undergraduate nursing leadership and management course. The students were assigned into groups. There were 5 groups with 7 students per group. The game activity was jeopardy and the students were given an opportunity to select from one of the five categories, each of which contained five clues which were valued by difficulty. Once the question was shown to the group, the group consulted with each other and prior to answering the question the students were charged to hula hoop or jump rope for 30 seconds before they could state the answer to the question.

**Teaching disease processes and procedures using the ASSURE model**: The ASSURE model incorporates Gagne's 9 events of instruction when presenting or delivering any form of educational content to novice or expert learners: (1) gain learners' attention, (2)inform them of the objectives, (3)stimulate learners' recall, (4)present the information, (5)provide guidance to facilitate learners' understanding, (6) have them demonstrate the skill, (7) give feedback to learners, (8) assess performance, and (9) enhance retention and transfer.
