

# Hearing Disciplinary Violation Flow Chart

This flow chart will be used by the Office of Community Standards & Civility or designee to address violations of the university's Code by WSSU students.

## Violation reported to/received by the Office of Community Standards & Civility



# Hearing Notification sent to student via rams.wssu.edu email account.

Notice list reported behavior, designated time/date/location of hearing, and supporting documents.



Administrative or Council Hearing will be conducted by the Director of Community Standards & Civility or designee to address alleged violation(s).

## No Finding of Violation

If a student is found not responsible for violating infraction(s).



### **Case Dismissed**

Conduct proceedings end, dismissal letter sent, and case is closed.

Director of Community Standards & Civility, Council, or designee will determine whether a violation has occurred, based on information presented and discussed during the Hearing process.

#### **Finding of Violation**

If a student is found responsible for violating an infraction, a sanction is implemented. Sanctions could range from an educational conversation to expulsion depending on the severity of infraction.
